The Track and Trace system for now will continue and the benches and the Church will be cleansed after Mass when necessary. At communion the stewards will direct each bench to come to the priest for communion. Please wait until it is your turn. We will resume confessions on Saturday at 4.30pm—5.00pm.

With the rate of infection slowly rising, I am very conscious that parishioners are still somewhat unsure of moving forward to quickly! Therefore I hope that these little steps will help us as a parish to move forward in a safe manner.
