DIGITAL COLLECTION PLATE (DCP). This is a new way for you to give your collection to the parish and hopefully for visitors coming to the Abbey to donate any offering they might like to give to the parish. It is very easy to use. First of all if you are a Gift Aider, you will need to visit our website to register (you will only need to do this once). Press the 'Donate' button, it will then ask for your name, post code and email address only. Once you have registered you can either donate on the website each week or use the Digital Collection Plate in the Church with the same card. If you are not a gift aider, choose the amount you would like to donate and tap your card. If the card doesn't register then insert your card in the slot at the top of the card machine and put in your pin number. This initiative will benefit the parish in all sorts of ways so please, if you can, use the DCP. Of course we will still have the usual collection bags at the offertory for those who wish to use them.
