ABBEY RESTORATION UPDATE: 10 months have passed since we started the restoration works and we now have a short break before phase 3 commences, so it is a good time to reflect on what has been achieved. Phase one was the most necessary with repairs that consisted of new stonework and partial chimney rebuild to St. Alphonsus Chapel, repairs to the slate roof & replacement of the roof joists over the north east aisle & cast iron rainwater goods in that area. The boiler extract system & stainless steel flue liner were also replaced. Phase 2 was the new roof to the Sacristy and the corridors with stonework repairs & replacement of stone to the windows in St. Joseph's chapel plus the stonework to the front of the choir room. Again, all of the rainwater goods in this area have either been replaced or decorated as well as adding insulation to the Sacristy roof. All this has been achieved thanks to the generosity and fundraising of our Parishioners. The next phase of work will be roofing repairs to the south aisle and organ room, together with the stonework and rainwater goods in that area. Commencement of these works are dependant, not only on the results of the recent bat survey but also on the continued support with the fundraising. We are awaiting the estimated costs of this work from the architect and contractor and will keep you informed as soon as we have more information. Please pray for the recovery of Fr. Micheal Ho, Parish Priest of Holy Trinity, Sutton Coldfield who recently suffered a stroke and is presently on the road to recovery. Patrick McAuliffe, Requiem Mass is on Thursday 24th August at 12.30pm, it will be held at St. Mary & John's Church.
